AVERAGE ADJUSTED WEIGHTS

Breedplan publishes Average Adjusted Weights in performance recording members' twice-yearly Group Evaluations, which shows the trend for each year since 1980 (therefore including information collected by MLC Signet). Some of this information is reproduced below.

These Average Adjusted Weights may be used as a guide, but it should be borne in mind that the information has been calculated from recording herds only.

200-day weight is recorded between 80 and 300 days of age; 400-day weight is recorded between 301 and 500 days of age; and 600-day weight is recorded between 501 and 700 days of age.

DAVID PHILLIPS MEMORIAL COMPETITION

This newly revised Competition will be distinct from the Lloyd & Whyte Young Handler Competition, and will encourage involvement in a multitude of different shows where South Devon classes are held.

The Competition will run in any one calendar year, and Summer shows with individual South Devon classes will qualify for the Competition. A minimum of two shows must be entered. There will be no maximum number of shows, and the two highest-scoring shows will count towards the final points.

Members, and relatives or employees of members, aged between 16 and 25 on the dates of their first and last shows will be eligible to enter the Competition. Cattle shown need not be the property of the Exhibitor, but must be prepared at the Show by the Exhibitor.

Entrants and exhibitors are invited to apply for Young Exhibitor cards from the SDHBS office in good time before shows are held, which must be handed to the South Devon judge of the classes *before judging begins*. The entrant should identify in which class he/she should be judged.

The judge will mark the Exhibitor with points out of ten, in each of three sections: Exhibitor's personal presentation; presentation of the animal; competence in handling the animal. The judge will be encouraged to ask pertinent questions of the entrants.

The judge will be responsible for returning the completed cards to the SDHBS office as soon as possible after the show, and in any case by 31st December.

The Young Exhibitor's two highest scoring shows will count towards the winning prize of £200, and a Trophy to be retained for one year will be presented at the AGM following the year in which the cattle were shown. In the event of a tie, the prize money will be shared equally among the winners.

The Competition may be held for as many years as the David Phillips Memorial Fund allows. It may not be won by any one individual more than once.

HEALTH ISSUES – TOXOCARA VITULORUM

Toxocara Vitulorum is a roundworm more commonly associated with buffalo, especially in tropical and sub-tropical zones. In recent years it has “migrated” northwards, and there are estimates by State Veterinary Laboratories that there could be an underdiagnosed problem in the national herd, with as many as 2% of herds affected. Untreated it can cause considerable damage, but it is relatively easily treated.

LIFE CYCLE OF THE WORM

The larvae of Toxocara Vitulorum are picked up by ruminants off the grass, ingested by the animal and migrate through the stomach into the tissue of the cow. During late pregnancy they migrate to the udder, where they are given to the calf in the milk, and possibly through the umbilicus.

It is in the calf’s stomach that they become adult worms, and here they lay their eggs to be passed out in the faeces, contaminating the soil for the next cycle.

Cows only transmit the larvae for 2-18 days. Eggs are only laid in the calf by the adult worm between 21 days and 3 months.

DIAGNOSIS

Symptoms in contaminated calves are similar to Coccidiosis, and include coughing (a single, forced cough), unpleasant-smelling greyish scour sometimes with blood and/or mucous, and the presence of eggs in faeces. Extreme untreated cases will result in severely damaged liver, frequent diarrhoea, and ultimately death.

TREATMENT

Early detection in calves to prevent the contamination of pastures is crucial to control and eradicate the worm. Calves can be treated with anthelmintics, such as Panacur at two weeks and six weeks of age, which will kill the adult worms thus preventing egg production. Calves should be housed for three months to ensure pastures do not then become contaminated.
